Culture Zone Wrocław is a local government institution, previously – as the Wrocław 2016 Office – responsible for the preparation and organisation of the celebrations of the European Capital of Culture Wrocław 2016. This experience, acquired knowledge, broad competences and contacts is something that we would like to share.

Culture Zone Wrocław is currently a network of seven places, such as Barbara, located in the very centre of the city, offering Wrocław residents a variety of cultural events. These are popular festivals at home and abroad: Santander Jazz on the Odra Festival, WROsound, International Children's Theatre Festival "Dziecinada" and the European Night of Literature. They also include such programmes as Microgrants, Neighbouring, Culture Practitioners and AIR Wro, the aim of which is not only to strengthen local initiatives, but also to promote them at the regional, national and international level.

Culture Zone Wrocław is simultaneously developing numerous networks of collaboration, especially with the cities with the title of the "European Capital of Culture" and Wrocław's sister cities. They are to serve the exchange of experience, practices and knowledge, as well as building strong partnerships for the coming years.

Selected thematic areas are based on the experience gained during the celebrations of the European Capital of Culture Wrocław 2016 and are still being developed within the programme of the Culture Zone Wrocław. Other topics may also be submitted.

- participatory projects involving local communities and residents of the city
- international projects, including the development of partnerships and networks
- organisation of major artistic events such as festivals, concerts and exhibitions
- cooperation at regional and national level
- volunteer work

We would like to introduce not only the Culture Zone Wrocław, but also our partners, with whom we have been working closely for many years: local and regional cultural institutions, non-governmental organisations, associations, initiatives and their creators, such as WRO Art Center (new media), TIFF Collective (photography), the Art Transparent Foundation (visual arts), the Avant Art Foundation (avant-garde music), the New Horizons Association (film), the BWA Wrocław Galleries of Contemporary Art (visual arts), the National Museum (visual arts), the Grotowski Institute (theatre) and the National Forum of Music (classical and contemporary music).
